- 5) Benefits the State of Texas & Taxpayers This program is funded *entirely* by sales revenue. Each year, millions of dollars in revenue is returned to client agencies and the State of Texas.

Vehicle Sales



- Vehicles are sold via online auctions and the State Surplus Store.
- At the State Surplus Store:
 - Vehicles for sale are located in the front section of the store parking lot.
 - Selling price and vehicle mileage are displayed on windshields.
 - Test drives are permitted in the parking lot, and you may bring a mechanic to look at any vehicle.
 - Accepted methods of payment are cash and cashier's check.
- After the sale, the vehicle's owning state agency is notified to begin processing the title transfer.
- Title transfer paperwork is mailed to the customer and takes approximately 21 days to receive.
- Customer takes title transfer paperwork to tax accessor-collector and pays the required taxes.
- All sales are final, no exceptions. Vehicles are sold as-is, where is with no warranties implied or expressed.
