

Who is eligible to purchase State Surplus Property?

Anyone in the general public may purchase state surplus property from our program. We offer two methods of sale—from our warehouses and through online auctions. Our headquarters, along with most of the property, is located in Austin, TX.

The **Texas Facilities Commission** is statutorily charged with administering the State of Texas's surplus property program. Surplus property comes to our agency from state agencies all across the State of Texas. You are welcome to visit our Storefront & Warehouse conveniently located right off of Hwy 183 in East Austin. Normal hours of operation are Monday-Friday, 8AM-4:30PM.

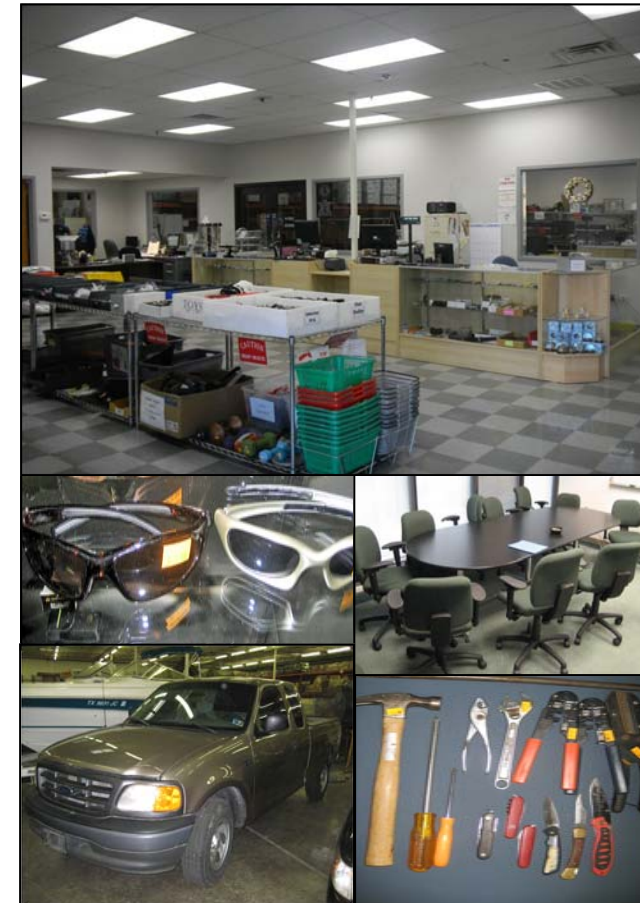

What Type of Property is Available?



- Cars, trucks & SUVs, including retired DPS vehicles
- Office furniture such as chairs, desks, file cabinets & shelves
- Office supplies, including toner, binders, and file folders
- Abandoned “airport property” such as knives, multi-purpose tools, toys, sunglasses, electronics, cell phones, belts, snow globes, watches & other jewelry (available @ Austin warehouse only)
- Watercraft, trailers, boats
- Radios & light bars (for law enforcement & fire dept. only)
- And much more!

Limited state surplus property is available at our San Antonio and Fort Worth locations.

Typically includes specialty items, as well as items located outside the Austin area. Auctions scheduled on as-needed basis.

Are discounts available for state agencies?

State surplus property priced below \$200 is FREE to state employees for agency use.

(Does not apply to airport or City property or items for personal use)

Is my organization eligible to receive surplus property via direct transfer **BEFORE** it is made available for sale to the public?

State agencies, political subdivisions (including vol. fire depts. and public schools), and approved assistance organizations qualify to receive surplus property via direct transfer before it made available for sale to the public.

Non-profit assistance organizations interested in obtaining surplus property must apply and be approved by TFC before requesting property. The application is available on our website.

When a Texas state agency has surplus property, that agency is required to advertise the property on TFC’s website for 10 business days. Eligible organizations can view available property at:

During the advertising period, only eligible entities may request state surplus property via direct transfer from state agencies. TFC determines the fee for transfers to political subdivisions and assistance organizations. After the advertising period, remaining property is offered for sale to the general public.
